The MAXAIR CAPR Hard Hat is part of a system intended to filter aerosolized and droplet particulates, and to provide head protection.

For Use With

Typically, the Hard Hat is part of the 2073-03 Hard Hat Helmet, and used with a 2400-090L Impact Lens, and either a HH Shroud or a HH Cuff, alternate Filter Cartridges and alternate Batteries, per tables below.

NOTE

The 2073-03 comes assembled, consisting of the Helmet, Liner, Hard Hat, and Power Cord. The following describes the assembly and disassembly of the 2061-04A Hard Hat to the Helmet.


Assembly - Hard Hat to Helmet



1. Locate the inside hole in the Hard Hat front Turn Clip, and the Helmet front Snap.



Place the Helmet front snap securely in the Hard Hat front Turn Clip inside hole.



3. Pull the Hard Had down over the back of the Helmet until its T-Tab hole is over the top rear Snap on the Helmet back.



 Continue downward movement of the Hard Hat until its T-Tab hole snaps securely on the Helmet snap.

Disassembly - Hard Hat from Helmet

To disassemble the Hard Hat from the Helmet, reverse the Assembly steps 1-4, above.
